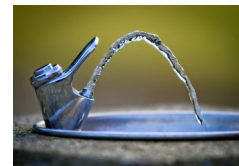
School lunch

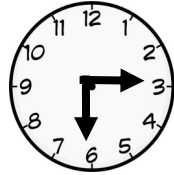

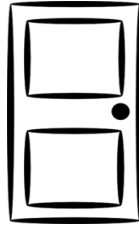


End of the day

Contact school if you are going to be late or another adult will be collecting your child.

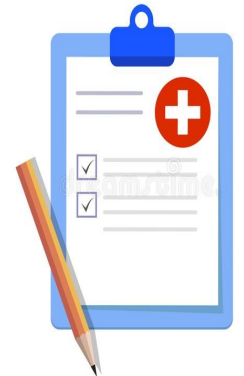


If your child is ill

Here is how you can support your child's learning at home.

A newsletter is sent every term explaining what your child is learning and how you can help at home.

Nursery:

- Share stories with you child.
- Play and talk about what your child is doing.

F2:

- Listening to your child read.
- Practice phonic sounds which are in your child's reading diary.

Year 1:

- Reading at home three times a week
- Practicing spellings in the Summer Term

Year 2:

- Reading at home three times a week
- Practicing spellings every week-the children have a test every Friday

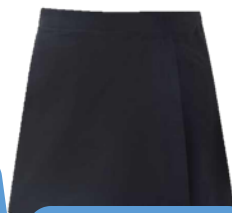

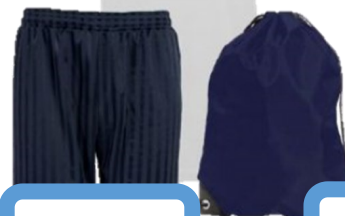
