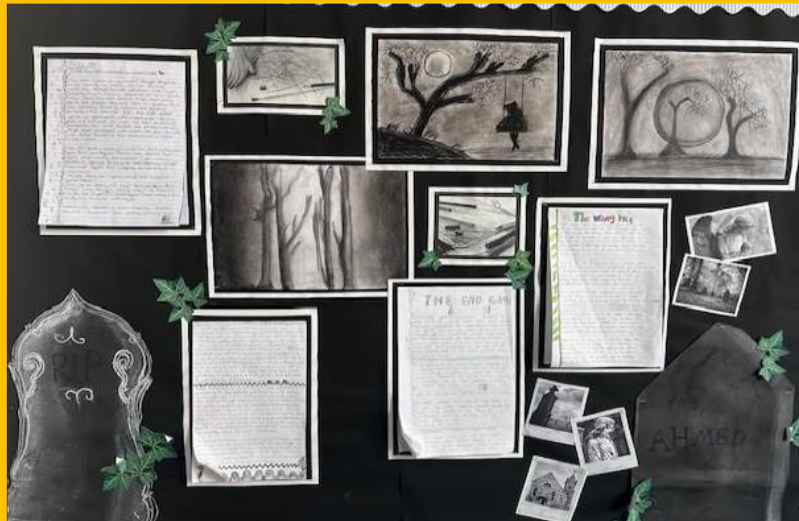


Year 6 Knowledge Organiser- Who's Lurking in the Woods (Book Study)

Vocabulary Dozen

Aroma	A distinctive odour that pleasant.
Cottage	A cottage is a typically small house which is old or old-fashioned.
Ensnare	Catch in or in a trap.
Monstrous	Having the ugly or frightening appearance of a monster.
Haul	Pull or drag with effort or force.
Scrawny	Unattractively thin or bony.
Famine	Extreme shortage of food.
Sharp-tongued	A person who uses cutting, harsh or critical language.
Sullen	Showing irritation or ill humour by a gloomy silence.
Stale	Food no longer fresh and pleasant to eat; hard, musty or dry.
Ford	A shallow place in a river or stream allowing a person to cross.
Bitter	Feeling or showing anger, hurt, or resentment because of bad experiences or a sense of unjust treatment.
