How is your local area different to an island?

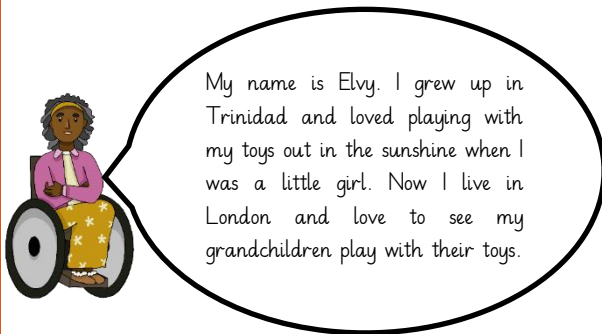
Our local area is different to Trinidad because we live in a city and Trinidad is a small island.
