Vocabulary Dozen

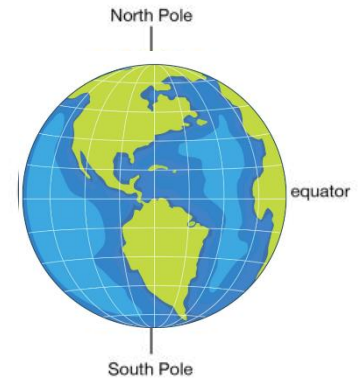
ocean	A part of Earth that is water.

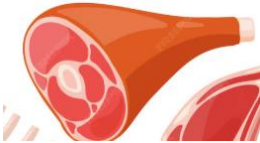
These are the 7 continents of the world

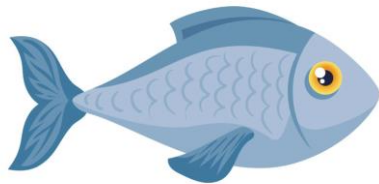
