

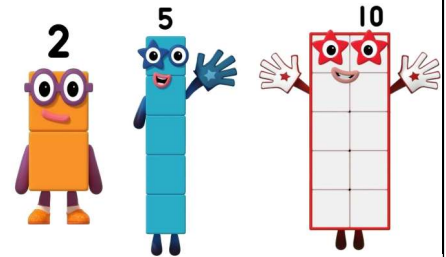
How to help support your child's learning at home?

Year 1

Maths

Children in Year 1 are expected to be able to count in 2s, 5s and 10s, as well as being able to double numbers.



The school follows a maths programme called White Rose.

Children are expected to read 3 times a week. Please read at home and write in your child's reading diary.

Tricky words are also sent home every week with your child please practise reading these at home too.

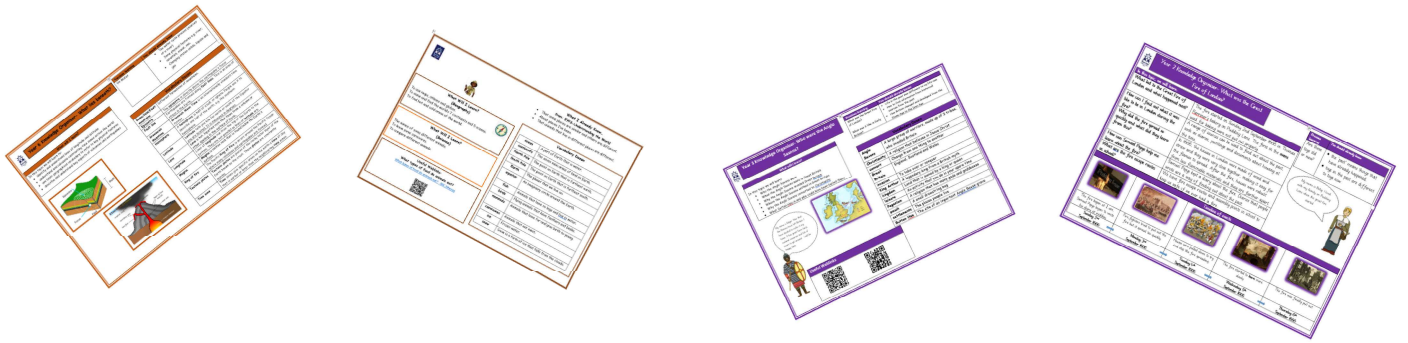


There is information on the website about our phonics and spelling programme called Little Wandle which can be found here
