

School Entrance Clearways – ZIG ZAGS



An important aspect of our School Enforcement Programme is to keep the School Zig Zags clear from all vehicles during restricted hours. The hours of restriction across Nottingham City Schools are **8:30 - 9:30am** and **2:30 - 4:00pm**.



Our Enforcement Teams have reported an increasing amount of buses dropping off and picking up on the zig zags. Between the restricted hours of **8:30 - 9:30am** and **2:30 - 4:00pm** NO VEHICLES are permitted to load/ unload or park on the zig zags. Buses that are picking up or setting down School children are not exempt from this restriction. All vehicles who contravene this restriction will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN).

Every parent wants their children to get to school safely, and Nottingham City Council's Traffic & Safety team are engaging with School staff and parents to help make the roads near schools as safe as possible.

A vital aspect of encouraging children to walk to School is their safety. The School Enforcement Programme is a multi-officer approach to address the issues holistically. All Schools are included into a rolling programme and receive a week of enforcement action. Safe parking doesn't just help those who arrive by vehicles; it also keeps the streets safe for children and adults too.
